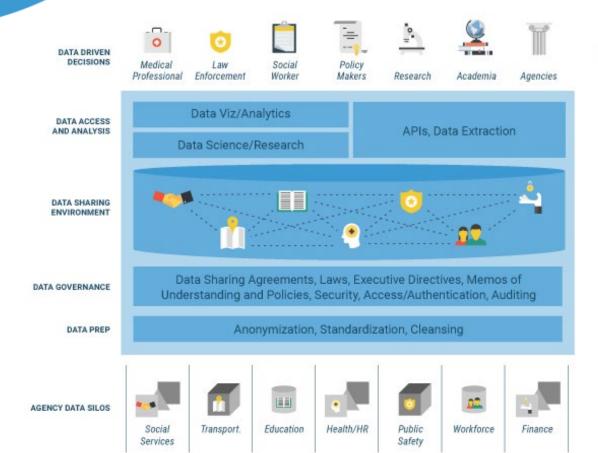
Phase 1 Objectives
